GENERAL ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Minimum Minor Requirements

1. 21 credit hours
2. 9 upper-division credit hours (3000-4999 level)
3. 2.0 Minor GPA.
4. Residency: At least 12 credit hours of the minor must be completed while registered at UCCS, with a minimum of 6 hours in upper-division (3000+ level) minor course work.

Student Responsibilities
